## **School Meals**

As a reminder, all students have access to breakfast from 7:45am to 8:00am and lunch at the corresponding grade level time. If your child does not bring lunch to school, please ensure that they are taking advantage of the free school lunch.

In addition, please ensure that your child brings a water bottle to school/ Hydration is especially important in the hot weather.

## **Masks**

Masks are required at school at all times, unless a mask break has been determined appropriate by a supervising adult. Please ensure that your child 1) knows how to wear their mask properly, 2) wears a mask that is clean and covers their nose and mouth, 3) is able to wear their mask, even in hotter weather.

Parents are required to wear a mask anytime they enter campus regardless of where they are standing. This applies to drop off and pick up as well.

## **Prescreen Students**

Parents remember to prescreen your student before arriving on campus. Please do not send symptomatic students to school. We will send them home.

Students should remain home:

- At least 24 hours have passed since resolution of fever without the use of fever-reducing medications; AND
- Other symptoms have improved; AND/OR
- They have a negative test for COVID-19; OR
- A healthcare provider has provided documentation that the symptoms are typical of their underlying chronic condition (e.g., allergies or asthma) OR a healthcare provider has confirmed an alternative named diagnosis (e.g., Streptococcal pharyngitis, Coxsackie virus), OR
- at least 10 days have passed since symptom onset.
