#### **Parent Portal**

#### RydeFreeRT

With RydeFreeRT, students in TK-12th grade can ride the entire SacRT transit network for free. This includes SacRT buses, light rail and SmaRT Ride on-demand microtransit services. It is available for any youth that live or go to school within SacRT's service area.

LAS is currently in the process of obtaining RydeFreeRT cards to be distributed at our site. In the meantime, passes can be picked up at any Sacramento Public Library and/or SacRT's Customer Service Center located at 1225 R Street.

Students can also use their LAS ID to ride SacRT.

<u>P4.1</u> Conduct an annual meeting to be held during the first trimester of each school year to inform parents of the programs and opportunities available to students through Title 1 and parent's rights to be involved.

<u>P4.6</u> Ensure **LAS staff (i.e. Parent Connector)** facilitate the process of involving parents in the developing/revising the School Parent Involvement Plan, School-Parent Compact, and parent involvement workshops and event opportunities where they learn ways to help in the classrooms.

<u>P4.7</u> Administer Climate Surveys (Programmatic Audit Surveys) on a yearly basis to evaluate the effectiveness of school programs and parent involvement opportunities. Survey results will be disseminated in a variety of ways.
