Winter MAP Growth

Students in K-5 recently completed Winter MAP Growth testing. If you haven't already, you will soon be receiving a Student Profile Report. This report summarizes how your child is performing academically, as measured by these most recent MAP Growth

assessments. These tests and scores help teachers check student performance by measuring achievement and growth.

MAP Growth tests are unique and adapt to your child's responses to measure your child's knowledge. If your child answers a question correctly, the next question is more challenging. If they answer incorrectly, the next one is easier. These results support in providing a more complete picture of where your child is on their learning journey- regardless of whether they are on, above, or below grade level.

Your child's MAP Growth results are represented as RIT scores. RIT scores have the same meaning across grade levels. This stable scale allows teachers to accurately measure each student's academic growth throughout the school year and over time.

We hope you find the Student Profile Report informative. If you have questions, do not hesitate to contact your child's teacher or the LAS office.


